Accepting Applications for June 7 - 8, 2025.

Applications MUST be postmarked by April 8 to be accepted.

Appropriate Size Space and Site Location for your demonstration will be determined by the Demo/Artisan Vendor Chair, Pam Scruggs.

SITES MUST HAVE A SCOTTISH THEME including signage and must be approved by the Demo/Artisan Vendor Chair prior to acceptance to the festival.

***While Demonstrators/Reenactors do NOT pay for a site, they are NOT officially accepted until receiving an acceptance email from the Demo Chair.**

The following are **NOT** allowed in GA Mtn Fairgrounds according to their Policies:

*Pets *Camping *Campers, RVs, or similar items in the Artisan/Demo areas

A Packet with Site location and Parking Area for vehicles and trailers will be given to you at Check-In.

All displays must be designed, constructed, and operated in good taste.

GMSFHG is a family friendly festival, therefore NO obscene items will be allowed. You may only exhibit items that are listed on your application & approved by the Demo/Artisan Vendor Chair.

Demonstrators/Reenactors must be in compliance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations of the U.S. and GA. The Demo/Artisan Vendor Chair has the authority to remove offensive items or escort argumentative demonstrators from the festival.

***Demonstrators/Reenactors must attend the festival in its entirety [Saturday and Sunday 9:00 - 5:00]. You may not set up late or take down early at any time UNLESS prior arrangements have been made.**

***Check-In:** Fri., June 6 from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM or Sat., June 7 from 7:00-8:30 AM.

***Pack-up time:** Sunday, June 8 BEGINS AT 5:00 PM.

*You will be advised by Pam or Jerome Scruggs or GMSFHG member if an earlier pack-up time is needed due to inclement weather.

***Demonstrators and Reenactors need to Check-Out with Pam or Jerome Scruggs (Demo Chair and assistant) on Sunday, June 8.**

****When accepted as a Demonstrator, your application signifies your consent to all rules.**

****We appreciate you and look forward to receiving your application postmarked by April 8.**

****The Georgia Mountain Scottish Festival Committee has final authority in all aspects of the festival.**
